

# The Recommendations

## Authentic Partnerships



**Communicate** with Black families in a way that values and respects their culture and as key stakeholders in their child's education.



**Build and promote** intentional partnerships that offer students + families tools for immediate and future academic success and their



**Facilitate spaces** that celebrate Black culture and heritage and intentionally makes room for Black families.



Offer or encourage exploration of a **counter story** if others correlate low Black family engagement to black family value/ interest in education.

## Direct Support

**Education Navigators** - knowledgeable, experienced professionals that can support Black families with choosing and enrolling in school.

**Education Advocates** - experts at advocating with and for Black students in SFUSD and their families.



## Impactful Connections

- **Equitable Access** to resources - create a reservation system for food pantries and offer free cooking classes with food pantry items.



- **Intentional + Impactful Connections** Cooking classes for food pantry visitors and intentional introductions (warm hand-offs) to resources.
